Council Meeting Highlight

Many of you know, the Council meets almost every month, the 4th Tuesday of the month. Council is composed of chairs of the church's various Boards and Committees, who bring reports of their activities, as well as issues, concerns that affect our wider church community. Anyone is welcome to attend, though only designated Council members can vote in the meeting.

One BIG issue that will be affecting our church: our lack of adequate funds. Like many other churches currently, our church has "shrunk" (members who have passed, or moved). We're down from membership of over 300 when I joined over 30 years ago, now to under 200.

Though we sold the parsonage, and invested the profit, the interest earned on investments comes nowhere close to what we have lost in our annual giving income. Especially as we are now going to have to substantially tap those investments to pay our staff salaries and bills. The trustees have looked at ways to reduce our bills; outside of setting our temps lower in winter, etc., the options are not many. (i.e., cheaper phone, Internet, etc.) **SO...** each board /committee has been asked to brainstorm ideas on how WE, the Church, are going to turn this around, to be presented at the January Council meeting. Then, (hopefully) in February, we want to broaden these discussions to the wider church membership; and gather additional ideas.

The idea is not to lay blame-- again, the position we're in is very common to most churches right now. So how can WE solve it? Put your thinking caps on, and/or share your thoughts with Dea Bishop, our Moderator, or any of chairpersons of boards/committees within the church.


