Pew discussions ongoing

The Trustees continue to research some changes to the sanctuary.

- 1) The possibility of removing the front pews to make space between the pews and the piano. This has been recommended as a safety measure.
- 2) To provide a place within the sanctuary that is designed for wheelchairs. This could mean removing part of some pews so that a wheelchair could fit within the pews.

The Church Council has discussed this matter and is asking the congregation to forward their comments, questions, and ideas regarding this matter to anyone on the Board of Trustees. Ted Guimond is the chairperson and he would welcome your comments by email.
